At the August Board of Education meeting, Board members adopted the tentative 2016-2017 budget. The Board will convene its annual budget hearing and consider budget adoption at its September meeting. The tentative budget represents a reduction in expenses by \$3 million. Through comprehensive planning and diligent spending, School District 21 has continued to provide for students' instructional needs despite the financial challenges imposed by the State of Illinois.

#### SUMMER CONSTRUCTION

Extensive work was done across the District this summer to prepare for the 2016-2017 school year. The contractors were diligent in working efficiently to complete the projects on time and under budget. Actual expenditures are projected to be about \$15,000 less than what was awarded by contract.
